BY-LAW 700-5-2

A BY-LAW RELATING TO THE PROMOTION OF HEALTH AND SAFETY OF THE INHABITANTS OF THE TOWN OF RIVERVIEW

<u>BE IT</u> ENACTED by the Council of the Town of Riverview under the authority vested in it by the <u>Local</u> <u>Governance Act</u>, SNB 2017, c 18 as follows:

Title

1. This by-law may be cited as the "Health & Safety By-law".

Definitions

2. In this by-law, unless context otherwise requires:

"Air Rifle" means any air rifle, air pistol, air gun or any other instrument or device for projecting missiles by air pressure obtained by mechanical means.

"Firearm" means a barreled weapon from which any shot, bullet or other projectile can be discharged and that is capable of causing serious bodily injury or death to a person, and includes any frame or receiver adapted for use as a firearm;

"Spring Gun" means any spring gun and includes any instrument or device for projecting missiles by spring pressure obtained by mechanical means.

"Shooting Range" means a place that is designed and intended for the safe discharge, on a regular and structured basis of firearms for the purpose of target practice or target shooting competitions and is approved and/or certified as a shooting range by the appropriate provincial and federal government agencies.

"Town" means The Town of Riverview.

Air Rifle, Firearms, Spring Guns

3. No person shall within the Town discharge an air rifle, spring gun or firearm except whilst engaged in target practice conducted exclusively within an appropriately designed and constructed shooting range. Any use or discharging of an air rifle, spring gun or firearm in a shooting range shall be subject to the provisions of applicable legislation, including the *Fish and*

Wildlife Act, SNB 1980 c F-14.1, the Criminal Code, RSC 1985, c C-46 and the Firearms Act, SC 1995, c-39, as well as the regulations thereunder.

Town Owned Property

4. No person shall erect, construct, build or cause to be erected, constructed or built any tent, shelter or building or park a trailer or recreational vehicle on Town property without first obtaining approval from a Town designate.

Penalty

5. Any person who violates any provision of this By-law is guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to pay a fine not to exceed the maximum amount payable under Part II of the Provincial Offences Procedure Act as a Category C offence.

Repeal Provisions

6. By-law R700-5-1 "A By-law Relating to Promotion of the Health, Safety and Welfare of the Inhabitants of the Town of Riverview", ordained and passed the 13th day of October, 2009 and all amendments thereto is hereby repealed.
