PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Riverview Town Council is considering amendments to the Zoning By-law. You have received this notice as a property owner within 100 metres of the area being considered for amendment.

The purpose of the proposed amendments (300-7-18) is to rezone a portion of the property bearing PID 05117688 from R1 – Single Dwelling to RM- Residential Mix in order to permit the construction of 72 semi-detached dwellings;

A public hearing to consider written objections to the proposed changes will be held on **Monday, December 9th, 2024 at 6:30 p.m** in Council Chambers. BY-LAW No. 300-7-18
