- Mr. Mitton began his wrestling career in grade ten at Riverview High School under coaches Tim Beatty & Ian Fogarty.
- Member (1998, 1999) and Captain (2001, 2002, 2003) of the University of New Brunswick's (UNB) wrestling team under coach Don Ryan.
- Four-time UNB Wrestling Team Most Valuable Player (1999, 2001, 2002, 2003).
- Five-time member of the AUS Champion UNB Wrestling Team (1998, 1999, 2001, 2002, 2003).
- Five-time Atlantic University Sport (AUS) Champion (1998, 1999, 2001, 2002, 2003).
- Five-time AUS All-Star (1998, 1999, 2001, 2002, 2003).
- Silver Medalist in the 64 kilogram division at the Canadian Interuniversity Sport Union (CIAU) Wrestling Championships (2001) in Thunder Bay and CIAU All-Canadian Honours.
- Awarded the James Downey Shield Award - UNB Male Athlete of the Year (2001).
- Named Atlantic University Sport (AUS) Wrestling Most Valuable Player (2002).
- Honoured with the UNB Chet & Helen Campbell Ring of Distinction (2002).
- Finalist in Sport New Brunswick's Male Athlete of the Year (2003) award category.
- Ninth place in the World Military Wrestling Championships (2003) in Istanbul, Turkey.
- Gold Medalist (Saskatoon, 2003) and Silver Medalist (Fredericton, 2004) at the Canadian Greco Roman Championships in the 74 kilogram division, representing the Fredericton Black Bears Club.
- Winner of the Canadian Olympic Trials (December 2003) in the Men's Greco Roman 74 kilogram division held in Edmonton.
- Competed as a member of Team Canada at the World Greco Roman Wrestling Championships in Cretail France (23rd Place, October 2003) and Olympic Greco Roman qualification tournaments in Novi-Sad, Serbia (31st Place, February 2004) and Tashkent, Uzbekistan (26th Place, March 2004).
- After graduating from UNB with a BScKIN (2003), Andy became an Assistant Coach at UNB, a board member with Luttès Wrestling New Brunswick, and a Major in the Princess Patricia's Canadian Light Infantry.
