Enhancing health services in Riverview would bridge these gaps – bringing primary care and related health services under one roof to meet the needs of our growing and diverse population.

The annual out-of-pocket health and personal care market size is estimated at \$17M, and research indicates a high demand for more physician, dentist, and health practitioner offices in town.⁵
