

# Council Highlights Regular Council Meeting – November 9, 2015

### **Public Presentation re: Amendment to the Municipal Development Plan**

Bill Budd presented on behalf of the Department of Urban Planning amendment to the Municipal Development Plan By-Law No. 300-32. The purpose of the proposed change is to introduce new policy and proposal criteria and guidelines to assist with the evaluation of new radio communication towers to ensure their compatibility with surrounding areas for the Town.

Council will accept and consider any written comments or objections until **Friday, December 9, 2015**. ## **Municipal Elections Act**

Council voted to support a reform to the Municipal Elections Act that would allow permanent residents of Canada the right to vote in a municipal election.

# **Codiac Transpo**

Council voted to defer a decision regarding adding funds to the 2016 budget for the proposed new transit routes until budget deliberations on November 19 and 21. Council did not want to make this budget decision, which could add more than \$100,000 annually, until it understood all other budget pressures and challenges.

#### Friends of Mill Creek

Council approved terms of reference for the Friends of Mill Creek advisory committee as presented by Director of Parks, Recreation and Community Relations Gerry Cole.

### **Riverview Lions Community Park**

Council accepted the master plan for Riverview Lion's Community Park. Implementation of any parts of the plan will be discussed during budget deliberations.

## **Appointments by Mayor Seamans**

Councillor Cecile Cassista was named liaison to the Multicultural Association of Greater Moncton Area (MAGMA).
