

Council Highlights Committee of the Whole Meeting – February 22, 2016

Presentations and Delegations

- Presentation by Daniel LeBlanc on the Petitcodiac Renaissance Plan. LeBlanc requested Council's support for the objectives of the Renaissance Commission, which will be mandated to accomplish by 2025 7 priorities designed to assist affected riverfront communities to achieve local economic and social spinoffs from the final stage of the Petitcodiac River Restoration Project, expected to be launched in 2016.
- Presentation by Roland LeBlanc, Director of Solid Waste for SE Recycle, informed Council of the South-East Regional Service Commission's plans for public consultation this spring. The SERC is proposing the addition of a third waste stream to increase successful diversion, and incorporating businesses and apartments into the waste sorting program.

Reports

• Codiac RCMP now provide a monthly report including an incident map for Council's review at the Committee of the Whole meeting.

Other Business

- Town will be a partner in the Community Transit Pass Program. The program will assist community groups and agencies with the transportation needs of Riverview, Moncton and Dieppe residents who cannot afford the price of a bus pass/ticket.
- Animal Control officers will no longer go door-to-door to sell Town of Riverview pet licences. Licences can be purchased from Riverview Town Hall and at any Riverview veterinary clinic.
- Council recommended a motion to approve the Strategic Land Management Policy that enables the Town to proactively dispose of surplus land and acquire land to respond to unexpected opportunities that may arise.
- Pop-Up on Pinewood continues for the month of February. The three tenants, Sequoia Downtown, Ocean Trail Source for Adventure and Café Codiac are reporting a positive experience introducing their products to Riverview customers.
- The Greater Moncton Chamber of Commerce held a successful 'Business After Hours' hosted by Adalin Properties at the Pop-Up on Pinewood on Feb. 18.
- Council congratulated staff on wrapping on another successful Riverview Winter Carnival.
