Being within one of the fastest-growing census metropolitan areas in Canada, the Town of Riverview, because of its ability to attract and its land availability, represents a huge opportunity for housing. Over the last few years, the rise in inter-provincial migration and the growing prominence of the millennial generation means housing demand is evolving in Riverview – a mix of smaller, affordable, multi-bedroom, and other rental types across the housing continuum are needed to fulfil the needs of our changing resident profile.²



GRANTING PROGRESS

The Town of Riverview's Commercial Development Grant is applicable to mixed-use, multi-residential projects that allocate at least 50% of the ground floor's real estate for commercial use.8
